

WEST IRVINE POOL RULES

1. Pool Hours:

Sunday through Thursday – 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
Friday and Saturday – 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

2. All residents are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their guests.
3. Residents may not have more than four (4) guests per household in the pool area at any time. A resident must always accompany guests in the pool, spa and/or barbecue area and the homeowner is responsible for the conduct of any guests. The pool/spa/barbecue areas cannot be used for private parties due to the limited space in the pool area.
4. The barbecue grills and picnic table area are available for use by residents and their guests. Use is on a first-come/first served basis; however residents may not occupy tables and/or barbecues for more than two (2) hours. Please clean table and cooking surfaces after use.
5. Pool users must present their pool key and a form of identification if requested by the Association's representatives.
6. No glass containers of any kind allowed in the pool or spa area.
7. Running, pushing, shoving, pulling in the pool/spa area and/or diving into the pool or spa are not permitted. Horseplay and boisterous conduct causes accidents and may hinder the enjoyment of the pool by others.
8. Floats, kickboards and swim fins, large toys and balls are not permitted in the pool. However, small inflatable toys may be used in the wader pool area, and non-swimmers may use flotation devices, such as noodles or water winds, in the pool and wader pool. Kickboards and swim fins may not be used when more than ten (10) people are in the pool.
9. No pets allowed in the pool, spa or barbecue area.
10. No riding of bicycles, skates, skateboards, rollerblades, or similar items will be allowed in the pool, barbecue or spa area.
11. Children under 14 years of age are NOT allowed in the pool area without a responsible escort, 18 years of age or older, in attendance.

12. No clothing other than normal swimming attire (e.g., no cut-offs) is to be worn in the pool or spa. Threads can clog the pool filters. Use colorfast swimming attire. Dye adversely affects the pool chemical balance.
13. Youngsters that are not yet toilet trained must wear diapers with leak proof rubber pants or swim diapers when in the pool and wader pool.
14. Each resident is responsible to ensure the pool gates are closed and locked when entering or leaving the pool or spa area.
15. If you smoke, please dispose of all cigarette butts in the ash cans provided.
16. The use of radios, personal music players, televisions, etc. is prohibited in the pool area, unless used with headphones or earphones.
17. No scuba equipment is permitted.
18. All residents and their guests, use the pool facilities at their own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
19. Use of profanity or obscene language is prohibited.
20. Please use a towel to protect the surface of the pool furniture.
